All bids shall be accepted on the condition that payment of the purchase price be made in full immediately upon acceptance of the successful bid. Successful bidders must be prepared to pay the amount due as a certified check or money order made payable to Plainfield Township upon acceptance of the successful bid. The bidder is responsible for all transfer costs associated with the sale of the vehicles and/or equipment, including any applicable sales tax. There are no warranties expressed or implied or no refunds; all listed vehicles and/or equipment are being offered for sale in their current condition.
