

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN- INTENT TO ADOPT ORDINANCE
PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of Plainfield Township, Northampton County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, at a regular meeting to be held on **Wednesday, November 13, 2019, at 7:00 P.M.** at the Plainfield Township Municipal Building located at 6292 Sullivan Trail, Nazareth, PA 18064, will consider the adoption of the following proposed Ordinance which is summarized below:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLAINFIELD, NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELIMINATING THE ASSESSMENT, LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF A PER CAPITA TAX IN PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP; REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 221 IN ITS ENTIRETY; AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PLAINFIELD TO REPEAL CHAPTER 24 (TAXATION; SPECIAL), PART 3 (PER CAPITA TAX) IN ITS ENTIRETY; SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; EFFECTIVE DATE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to repeal Ordinance Number 221 in its entirety and to amend the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Plainfield to repeal Chapter 24 (Taxation; Special), Part 3 (Per Capita Tax) (§24-301 to §24-312) to eliminate the assessment, levying and collection of a Per Capita Tax on the residents of Plainfield Township.
