**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE QUALITY OF LIFE AND
VIOLATIONS TICKET PROCESS IN PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to address issues pertaining to the general maintenance and upkeep of properties (including but not limited to the accumulation of rubbish and garbage, the cleanup of animal waste and the storage of inoperable/non-registered vehicles) that contribute to the deterioration of property values and diminished quality of life for residents within Plainfield Township.
