

NOTICE TO BIDDERS/INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals for the Getz Road Culvert Replacement will be received electronically via the PennBid program by Plainfield Township, Northampton County, until 3:00 pm prevailing time on Thursday, September 3, 2020. Bids will be received from PennBid and tabulated results will be available on PennBid after the bid opening on the same day. Action is planned to be taken by the Board at their monthly meeting on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 at approximately 7:00 pm via Zoom teleconference. Teleconference information for the September 9, 2020 Board of Supervisors meeting will be provided under the heading of 'Board of Supervisors Agenda' at www.PlainfieldTownship.org prior to the meeting in accordance with Act 15 of 2020.

Work to be performed under this contract shall include all labor, tools, equipment and materials necessary to construct the Getz Road Culvert Replacement including removal and disposal of the existing culvert, selective tree clearing and grubbing, all excavations, stream diversion with pump bypass and cofferdam, and installation of a 7.5' wide x 3.5' high precast concrete box culvert system with precast wingwalls as well as restoration of the roadway, surface stabilization and erosion and sedimentation controls required for the work.

All work must be completed by March 1, 2020. Liquidated damages apply at the rate of \$250.00 per calendar day. All quantities listed are approximate. All materials shall be PennDOT approved or pre-approved equal. Each bidder is required to bid on the total project. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check made payable to 'Plainfield Township' in the amount of 10% of the total bid. The successful bidder shall provide a performance bond or certified check to the municipality in the amount of 100% of the contract and a payment bond or certified check to the municipality in the amount of 100% of the contract within 7 days after the contract is awarded. All Bidders must complete and submit with their bid the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Public Works Employment Verification Form as per Department of General Services Act 127 of 2012".

This project was financed in part by a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Commonwealth Financing Authority. As such, all Contractors and Subcontractors are required to pay PA Prevailing Wages Project Rates, comply with the State Contractor Responsibility Program, Contractor Integrity Provisions, equal opportunity, the Commonwealth Nondiscrimination/Sexual Harassment clause and any other applicable statutes/regulations within the bid documents as well as submit all forms and certifications requested by and cooperate fully with representatives of the funding agency, the Engineer and the Owner.

The municipality reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive any irregularities, to negotiate contract amounts, to accept any bid which, in its judgment, is in the best interest of the Township and to delete any items or portions of items, if necessary.
