Dear Plainfield Township Commission,

My PAHS students and I are looking forward to working with you to clean up the outdoor recreational facility. There are a few key details that must be answered before I can finalize the date.

First, do you require any type of insurance coverage for the students I will be bringing to work? I know that PAAHS has secured coverage for Pen Argyl, but I am not sure if you need more information.

Next, I would like to complete this project the week of 4/17. My first choice is 4/18; I can be flexible, but I do need to make sure I can secure a bus. (Please note that I do not want to do this on a Monday.) I also need to secure a raindate--a few days later or the following week.
